

## ISC/WP Training of Trainers-2009

The first round Integrated sustainable Solar Cooking and Water Pasteurisation (ISC/ WP) ToT has successfully been completed.

13 trainees recruited from 4 organisations participated the ToT from May 25-30, 2009 at Bishoftu (exDebreZeit) PISDA regional ISC production and learning centre.

Four organisations from Central Rift Valley (CRV), Northern Highland (NH) and Addis and surrounding clusters sent their trainees to this first round ToT.

In summary, the numbers of trainees from each organisation are:

AwraAmba from NH 4 trainees and

Burayu TVET from Addis and surrounding 3 trainees

The 6 days training was programmed in accordance with both theoretical concept of the objectives, methods of production and usage and gradual introduction to practical manipulation of instruments and cookit production and water pasteurisation processes. At the end of the 6 days each trainee produced her/his cookit kit and learned water pasteurisation and finally each of them cooked food separately for their graduation ceremony.

Each trainee was provided with full kit and the user manual prepared by PISDA. The manual was written in Amharic and easy to understand and use.

PISDA has also trained one group of trainees from other organisation known as Jerusalem Youth and Community Development Organisation (JECCDO) from 18-23 May, 2009 just one week before the present ToT. This helped PISDA to develop more experience and improved more for the present training. They completed this first round programme without any confusion or difficulty.

The trainees also appreciated and are very satisfied with overall delivery systems and the way the training was programmed and organised. They told that they acquired the basic concept of solar cookers and practical production of cookit kit and usage, which they considered very difficult and impractical on the first day.
